Visiting patients in their house has become part of our regular activities. The houses are scattered and the distances between one and the other are notorious. The only way to access these houses is on foot. This means that access is very limited and the personnel of the Ministry of Health have limitations to attend to patients who need to be visited at home. Some members of the Con Corazon team have the opportunity to go see these abandoned patients. We walk to Roberto's house, whose right leg is swollen due to an infectious process resulting from a motorcycle fall. We administer antibiotics and anti-inflammatories.



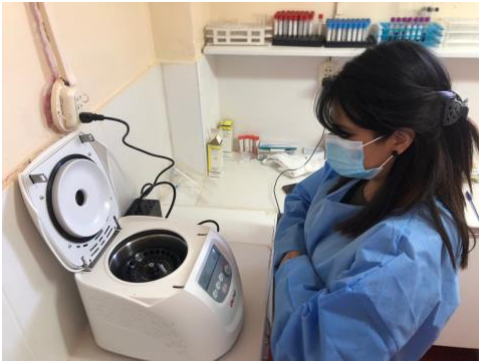
Activities
