

## Con Corazón Outreach Report

13<sup>th</sup> September 2022 – Marampaqui

The weather in Marampaqui is extreme and can also be unpredictable. We consider it normal since we are at an altitude of 4000 masl and here it is possible to have different climates in one day. On the one hand, winter is very cold and the rainy season is unstoppable. On the other hand, the sun is very strong in spring. The winds are also powerful at this time, to the point of blowing away our medical center sign like a kite. The people from the village will take care of repairing the sign for our next visit.



### Activities

We have contacted the doctor from the Tinke village. She works within the primary health center that belong to the Ministry of Health. Her name is Dr. Ingrid and she was very happy to be part of our team. We expect to work with her in our next outreach.

- General Medicine, 30 patients were seen.
- Dentist, 14 patients kept the dentist busy.
- Laboratory, 11 lab exams were performed by our biologist Wendy.
