10th November 2022 – Marampaqui

Many of our patients are waiting for our arrival since 6.00 a.m. because they do not want to miss the opportunity to be seen by the doctors in our medical center. We normally arrive around 9.00 a.m. and find out that the patients are already passed through triage thus they all know the place that corresponds to them to be attended. The ones who arrive late go to the last spot on the queue and have to wait until approximately 3 p.m.

What do they do while waiting?

Some patients, bring their food along with them, which allows them to share with others. There is also a family who prepares fried trout with boiled potatoes and sell it to our patients. Men take advantage of this time to talk about business and get to an agreement that day since there is plenty of time to come to terms. Some women spin the wool with a spindle, that is, they twist and roll the fiber. This technique is thousands of years old and allows them to spin to finally create a ball ready for weaving.

- Dentist, 12 patients were seen by our dentist
- Laboratory, 8 lab exams were performed.
