09th March 2023 – Marampaqui

The strike announcements continue, but only the announcements. On this occasion, it seems that people got tired of this situation. "We all need to work" repeat the residents of Marampaqui.

Likewise, when we arrived in Marampaqui, there were too many patients. Many reported that they had walked more than 3 hours to get medical or dental attention and that they did not reach a quota. Some arrived early, but the quotas had already run out. Many arrived at 02:00 and were the ones who obtained the right to be seen by the doctor. Sadly, we had to say NO to 54 people who needed our service.

We also delivered fifteen SMS to the beneficiaries of Marampaqui. We explained to them how the installation of the ovens should be done in their respective homes. Each one received an oven with all its components through a list with their names and identification documents. Community leaders were present at this activity who carefully listened to the instructions. It seems that they have realized that this will change their lifestyles in a positive way.



Activities

Medicine, we have seen 25 patients.

Dentist, 13 patients, mostly dental extractions.

Laboratory, 11 lab tests were done.
