One of the most vulnerable age groups that Con Corazón targets are children. Due to their poverty situation and lack of parental concern, they tend to get sick more frequently. Also, during the changing season period, they suffer from respiratory diseases.

An important barrier that brings many challenges to our team is fear of the doctor. This is explained as follows: Most parents in this region, when children misbehave, threaten their children with taking them to the doctor. They use words like "if you don't well behave, I'm going to take you to the doctor so that he can give you a sermon, saying that you are a bad child" or "if you don't eat your lunch, I'm going to take you to the doctor to give you an injection." So, when children come into the hands of our doctors, they believe that something bad is going to happen to them. However, at the end of the day, our Con Corazon team is responsible for serving them in a friendly manner and always with a smile.
