14th February 2025 – Marampaqui

The residents of Marampaqui never had access to magnifying glasses. For generations, living with blurred vision was normal. Many older adults couldn't read, sew, or recognize faces from a distance. Children in school struggled to keep up with classes due to their difficulty seeing the blackboard. Without access to an ophthalmologist or the financial means to purchase glasses, eye health was an unaffordable luxury.

However, everything changed thanks to the arrival of the NGO Con Corazón. For the first time, a volunteer medical brigade arrived in the community, evaluating the residents' eyesight free of charge. Adapted glasses were given to those who needed them, opening up a new world of clarity and detail. Smiles of amazement were immediate: women rediscovered their embroidery threads, children read their first books fluently, and grandparents once again saw their grandchildren's faces clearly.
