In every medical and dental campaign, we conduct, we make it a priority to provide our patients, especially children, with their own toothbrushes. This simple yet essential tool often marks the beginning of better oral health for many in the remote community of Marampaqui. Before distributing the toothbrushes, we take the time to educate patients on how to use them properly and explain the importance of daily oral hygiene. We use interactive demonstrations and child-friendly explanations to ensure they understand the value of brushing their teeth regularly.

For some of the residents of Marampaqui, especially in more isolated areas, this is their first time owning a toothbrush. Many have lived their entire lives without access to basic dental care or hygiene tools. It is both humbling and inspiring to witness the gratitude and curiosity on the children's faces as they learn how to care for their teeth. These small acts, teaching, sharing, and supporting, are part of a larger effort to build healthier habits and improve the well-being of the entire community. By giving them knowledge and tools, we hope to create lasting change that goes beyond a single campaign. Oral health is a right, and we are committed to making it accessible to all.
